This amends the August 1, 2022 Report on all Questions received and answers given. Four additional questions were received in time following release of the August 1 report and the answers given are added to that report herein.

Question 27: Section 3.4 Cost Proposal A. Costs are to be identified per deliverable. Is there a list of deliverables that the contractor is to include in the proposal/budget?

Answer: Yes, part of the proposal would include items proposed as deliverables.

Question 28: What legislation allocated the funding, i.e. \$200K for this pilot training program?

Answer: Funding was provided by a decision package that allows us to use funds from our dedicated 12M fund for Charities Education.

Question 29: If the funding came from a grant, can you share the grant requirements?

Answer: The funds are not from a grant. The funds will be issued based on the review and selection of the RFP.

Question 30: Is the expectation to create the training for the state interfacing with the non-profits/charities?

Answer: That would be part of the proposal to identify what tools/methods/approach would be used by the successful bidder.
