In September, staff member Bonnie Hood will present at the Council of State Archivists Conference in

Salt Lake City on Washington's grant program. Hirotaka said the Archives recently completed its budget preparation for submission to the Office of Financial Management. She also announced that in September, the Washington State Constitution will be displayed at the Spokane Public Library during U.S. Constitution Week, alongside other items from the Archives' collection. Additional showings are planned on the west side of the state at the start of the legislative session. She invited those interested in attending or hosting similar events to contact the Archives.
