Fact: Adopted as the state fish in 1969, steelhead trout can live up to 11 years and grow to nearly 55 pounds.



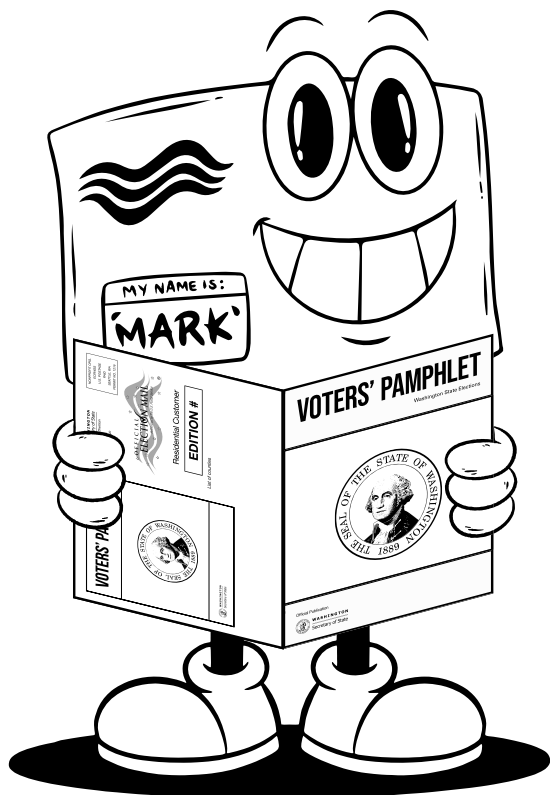
Fact: Starting in 1983, Washington state allowed counties to hold special elections by mail. Washington has been fully vote-by-mail since 2011.



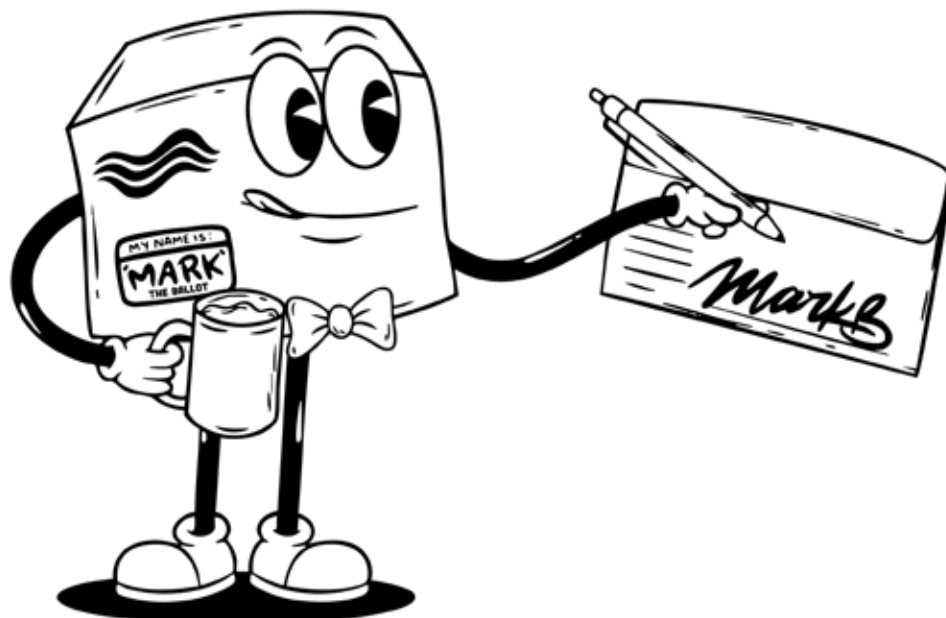

Make your mark!

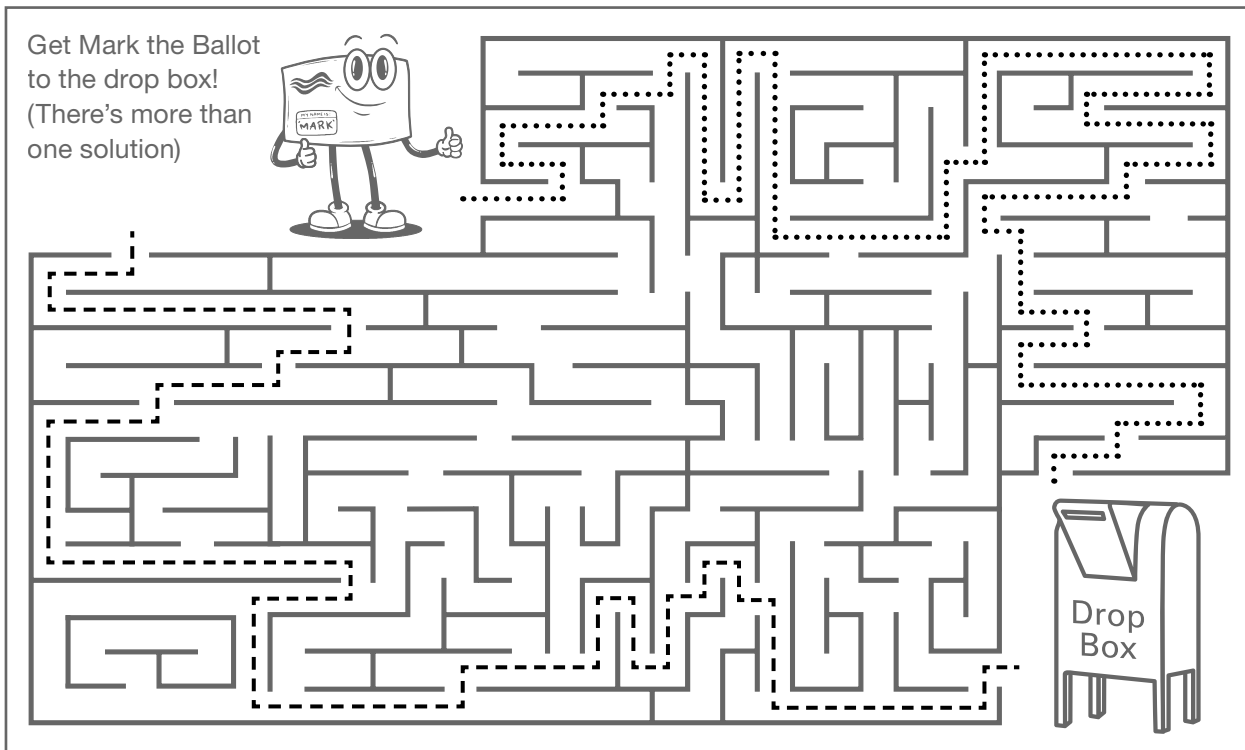

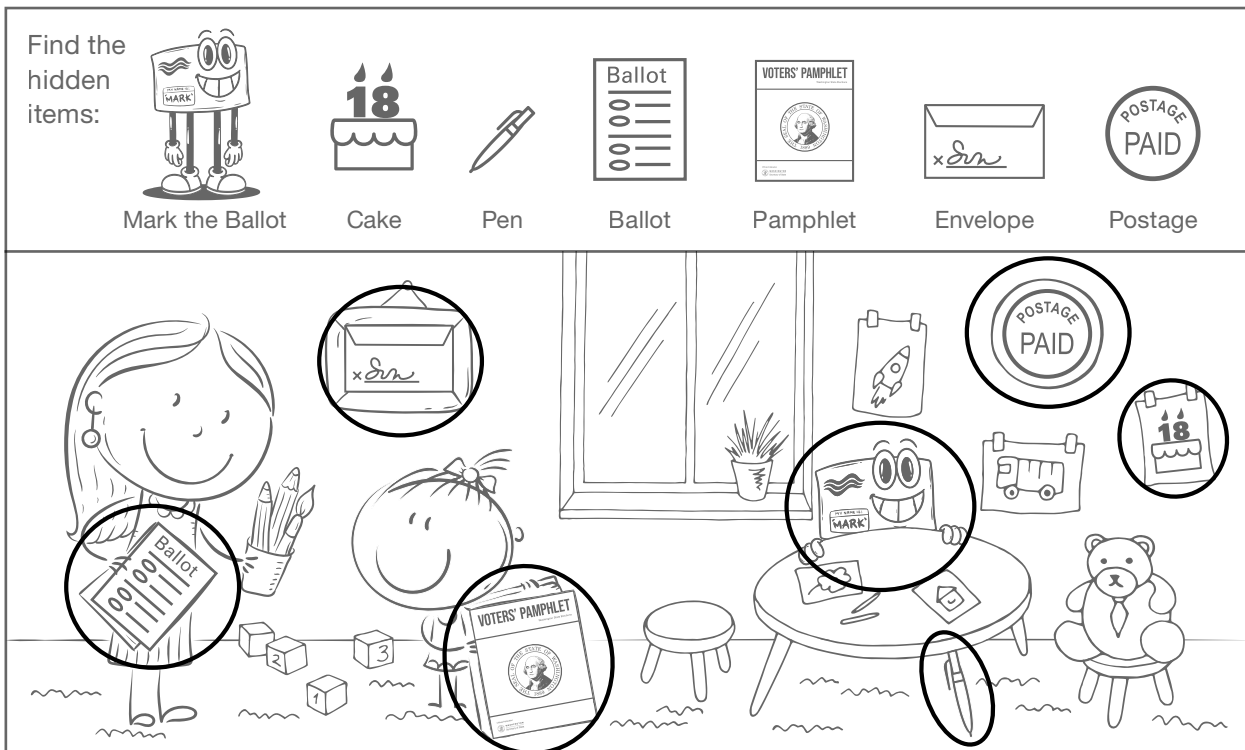

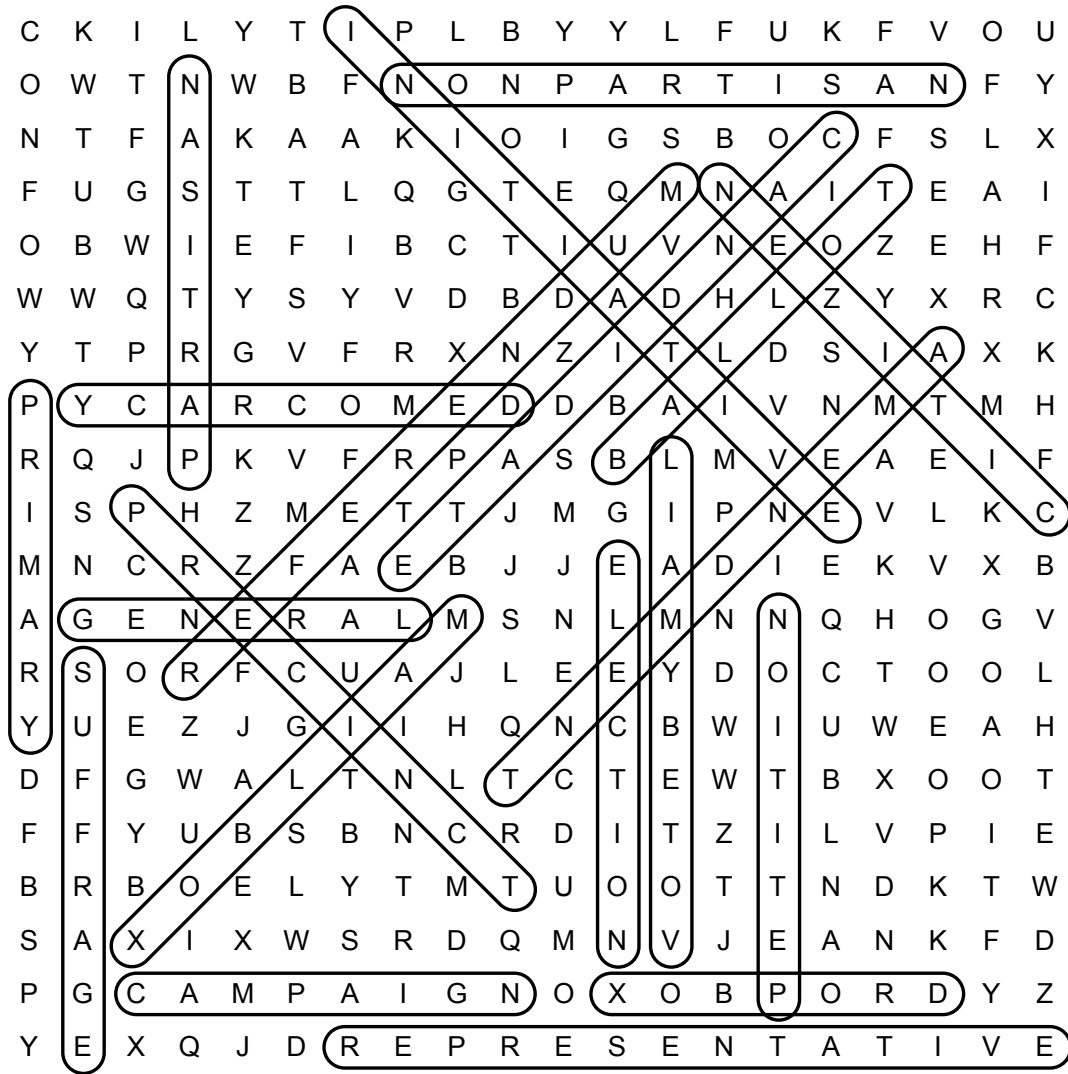
