## Key dates



**October 17** — Start of voting period and deadline for counties to mail out ballots to voters

**October 27** — Last day for online and mailed registrations or updates to be received

**October 28** — USPS recommends mailing voted ballot back at least one week before Election Day

**November 4** — Election Day:

- Register or update info and vote **in person** by 8 p.m.
- Mailed ballot must be **postmarked** by today
- Official ballot drop boxes are open until 8 p.m.

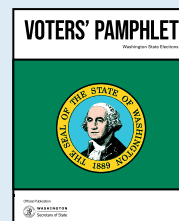
**November 25** — County canvassing boards certify General Election results

**December 4** — Last day for Secretary of State to certify General Election results

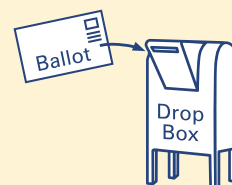
